Project Proposal Title	Development of foundations for scientific cooperation between Balcan countries and Republic of Belarus with the aim of ensuring of common EU Transport Space

Abstract (Max. 2000 words)	<p>Strategy for development of scientific cooperation in the field of transport has two components of different levels. One of them is of global character, because of in our days the presence of close contacts between countries is a permanent condition for successful scientific and technical development of every country (region). The second level of concrete practical proposals and solutions follows directly from this general thesis.</p> <p>It is known, that the main road of Republic of Belarus is highway M1/E30 "Brest – Minsk – frontier of Russian Federation", connecting EU countries with Russia via Republic of Belarus (606 km). At that time this road is a part of so-called Crete corridor II, defined by EU in connection with importance of its trade flows as having the highest prioritet between all Crete corridors. In addition to this, motor road M-8 up to the frontier of Ukraine, having extension about 456 km via Republic of Belarus and connecting Finland, Lithuania, Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, Moldavia, Rumania, Bulgaria and Greece, is a part of Crete transport corridor IX. The branch of Crete transport corridor IXB "Gomel – Minsk – Vilnius – Klaipeda" (468 km via Republic of Belarus) is so of great importance.</p> <p>Reasoning from the necessity of prolongation so-called Pan-European transport corridors from West to East, forming of international roads on the territory of Republic of Belarus, inclusion of Belarus national transport net in the system of international transport corridors are the most important aims of Belarus transport scientist activities. Transport science of EU and Belarus is facing with an acute problems, as well as the ways of their solution. All this demands permanent relations, information and experience exchanges with EU scientists, and especially with Balcan scientists. Cooperation of Balcan and Belarus scientists is of great interest, because of the process of adaptation of institutions and legislative base to needs and standards of market economy is very common in a number of aspects.</p>
